**Stephen D. Brokenshire, Mineral Resources Specialist for the Pennsylvania Dept. of Environmental Protection (DEP)**, will discuss the duties and roles of the DEP in regulating Marcellus Shale drilling and other activities. The presentation will include 30 minutes of interactive discussion with the audience.

Mr. Brokenshire has been employed by the Department of Environmental Protection for nearly 11 years as a Sanitarian, Environmental Protection Compliance Specialist, Water Quality Specialist and Mineral Resources Program Specialist. His primary job duties include interpreting and recommending changes to rules and procedures for the Office of Oil & Gas Management; conducting evaluations of regional or district programs to ensure uniformity of actions; developing technical program guidances; and conducting technical investigations of issues and problems. Mr. Brokenshire has a bachelor's degree in Earth & Environmental Science from Wilkes University with a concentration in Water Quality.
